Bringing together data infrastructure users and providers and policy makers from across Europe, the EUDAT Conference will:

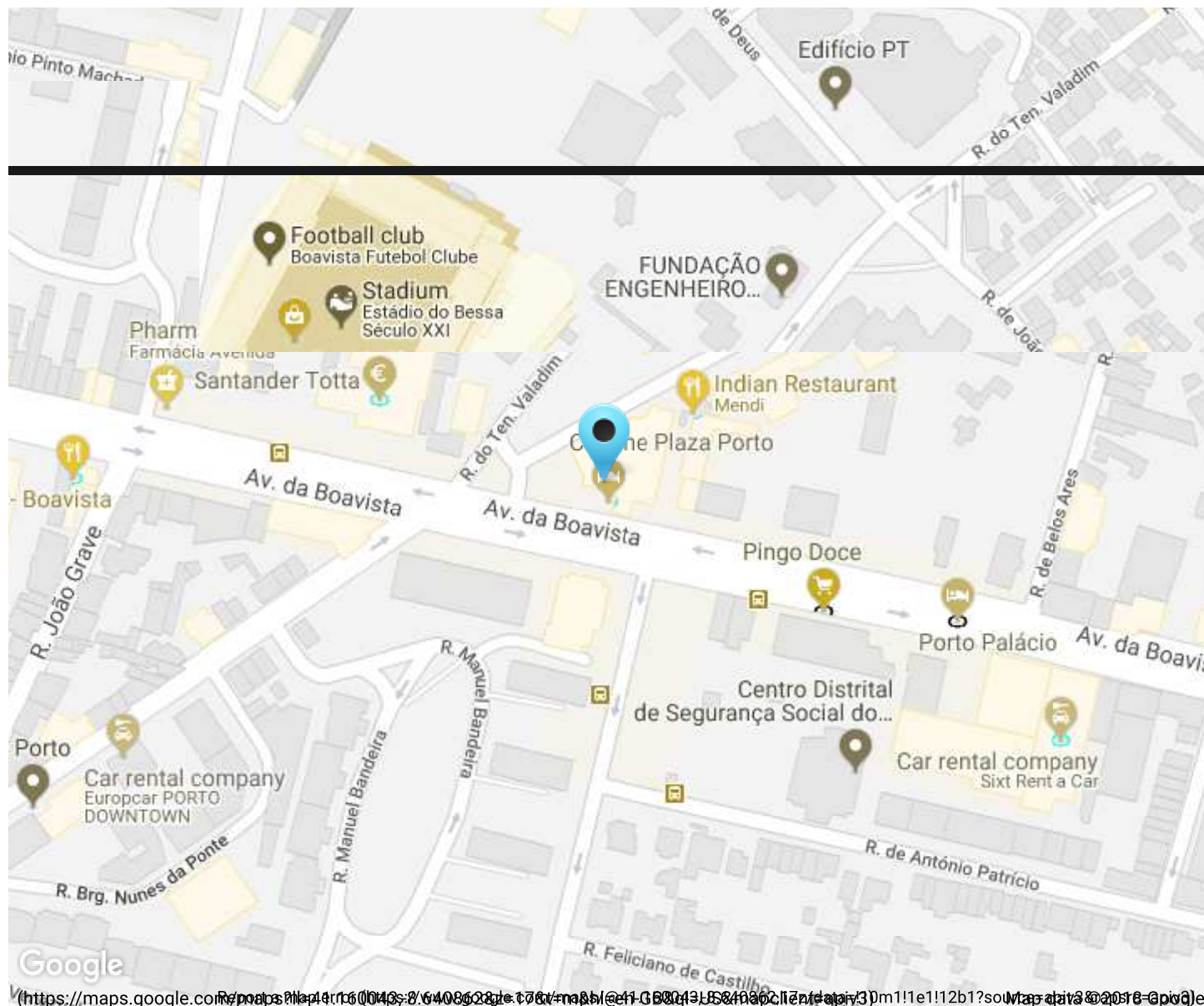

The CESSDA Strategy builds on three pillars: technology, training and trust. Technology ensures a stable and up-to-date backbone for our products and services, for single sign on and other tools that should make data deposit and data use more easy. Training focuses on "train the trainers" and new training modes for outreach to new users, explain on data privacy issues, etc. Trust refers to the position of the CESSDA service providers, e.g. as "trusted repositories", to ensure quality of data, and safe and secure access.
