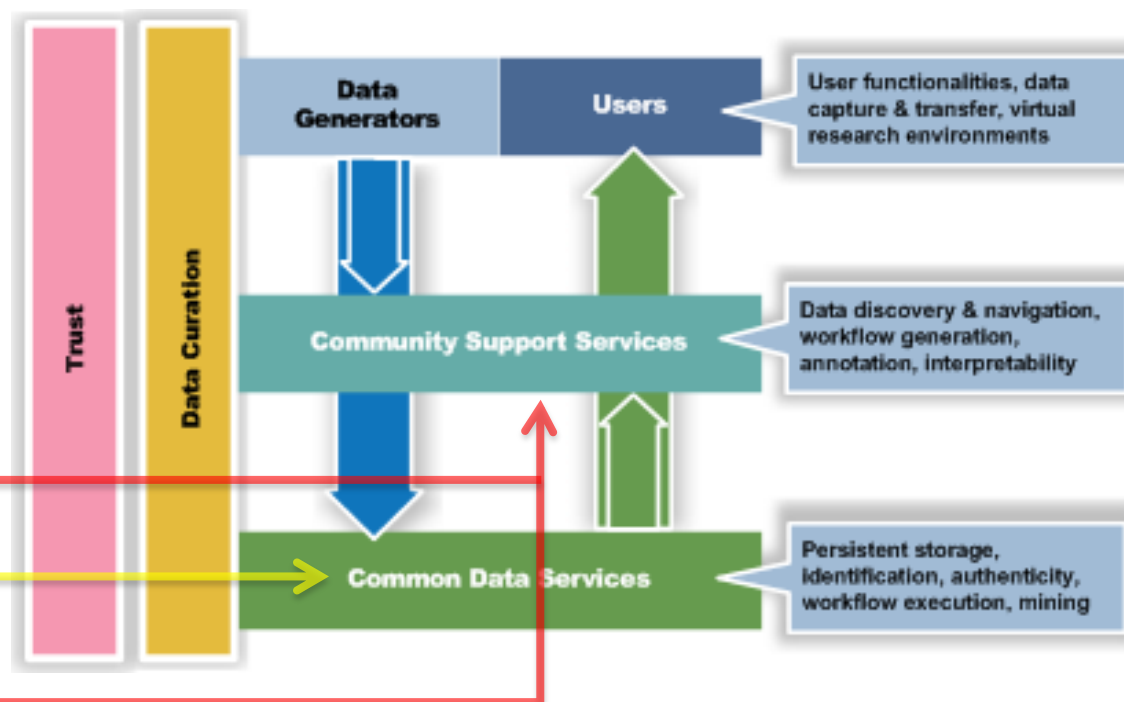
Services of the EUDAT CDI

Extended Core Services (community)

- Joint meta data service
- Joint data mining service



Service delivery

1. Community requirements analysis
 2. Service and service infrastructure building
 3. Deployment and operation
- Production services are delivered after approval
 - Some internal and community services with existing building blocks are provided on demand
 - Status: ready for hosting community services

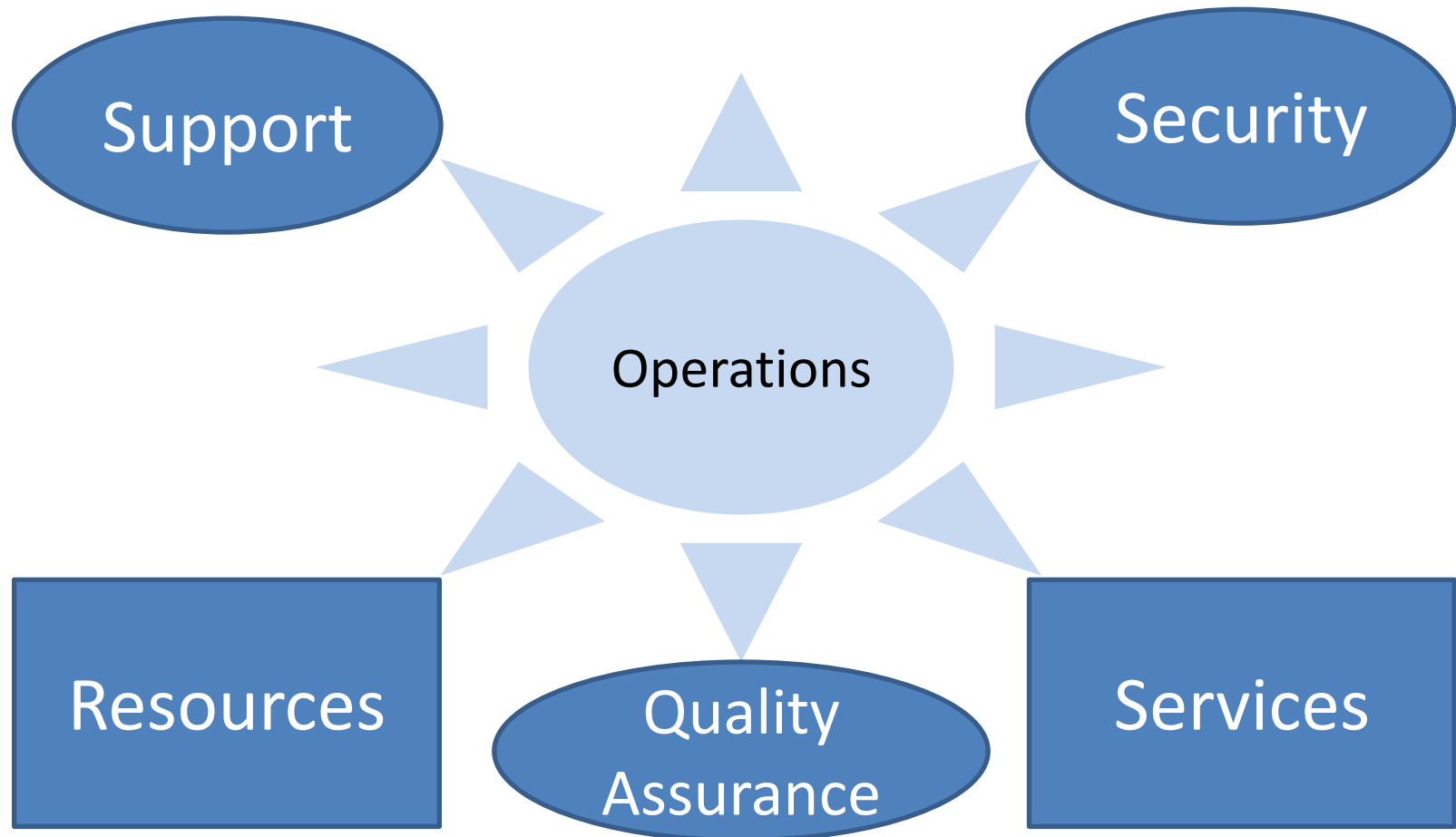
Service Provisioning

EUDAT as an infrastructure is making services available in a coordinated way.

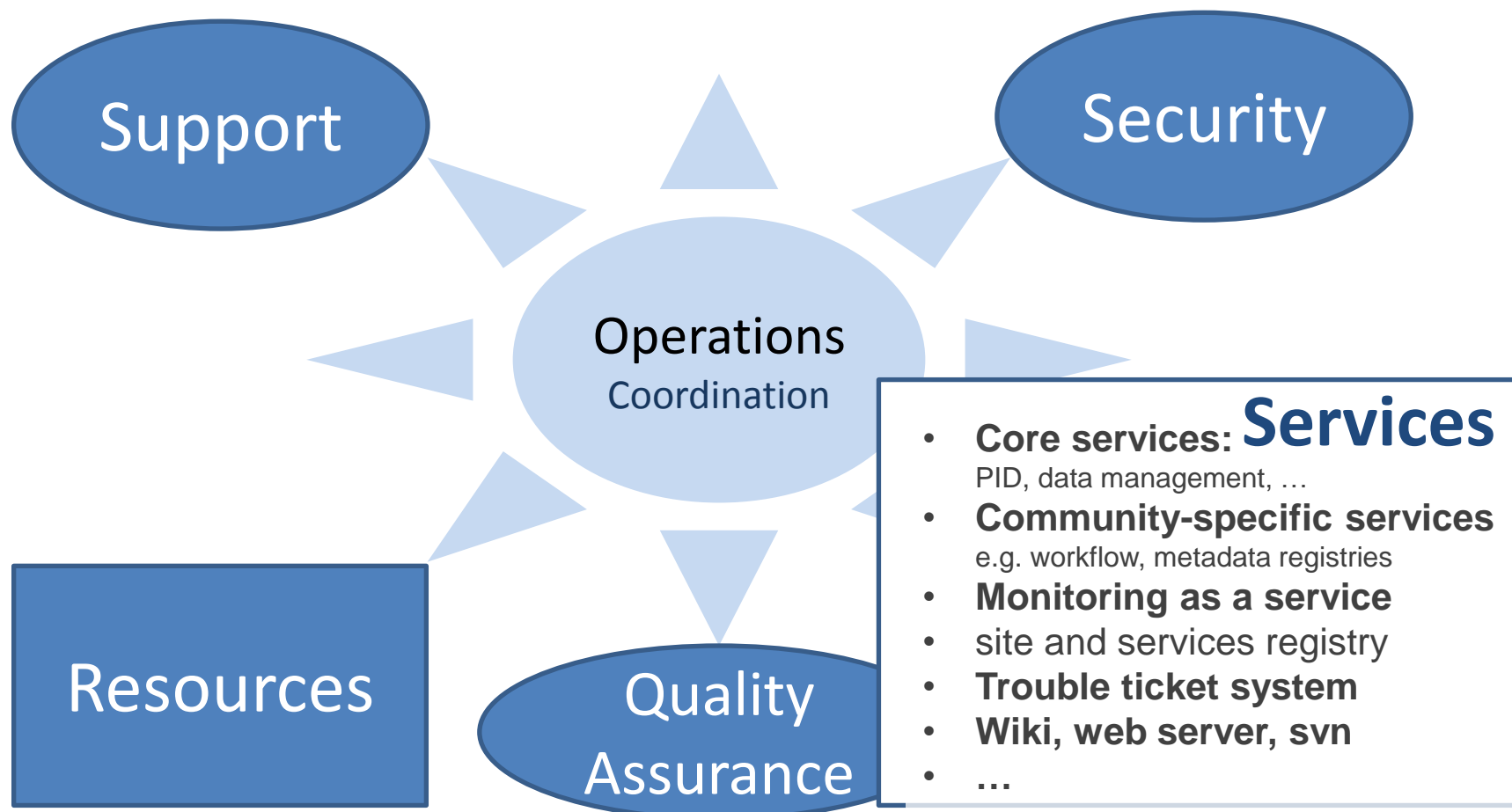
Service Hosting

Resources are provided on which services are deployed, integrated and run as components of a service infrastructure .

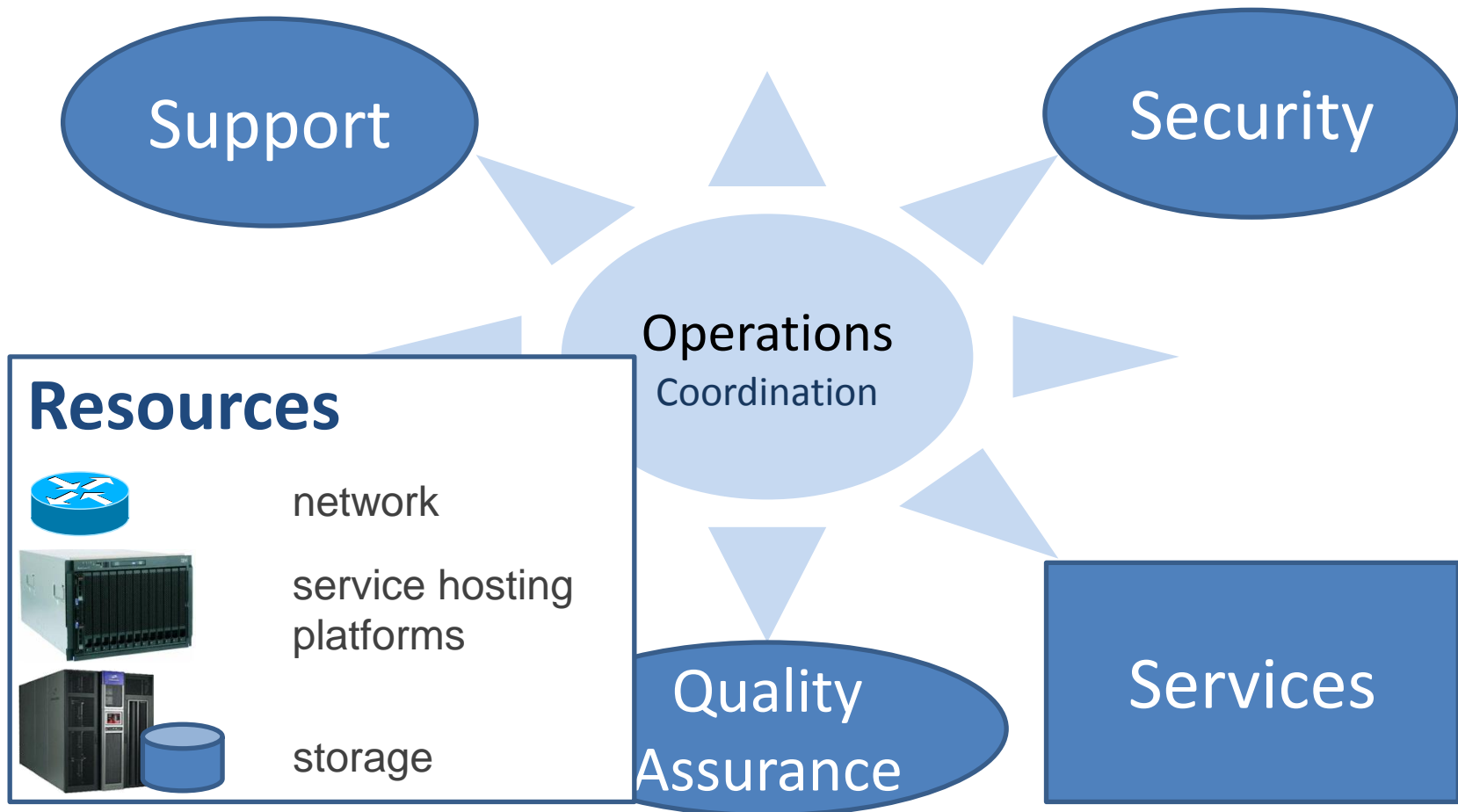
Organisation of EUDAT Operations

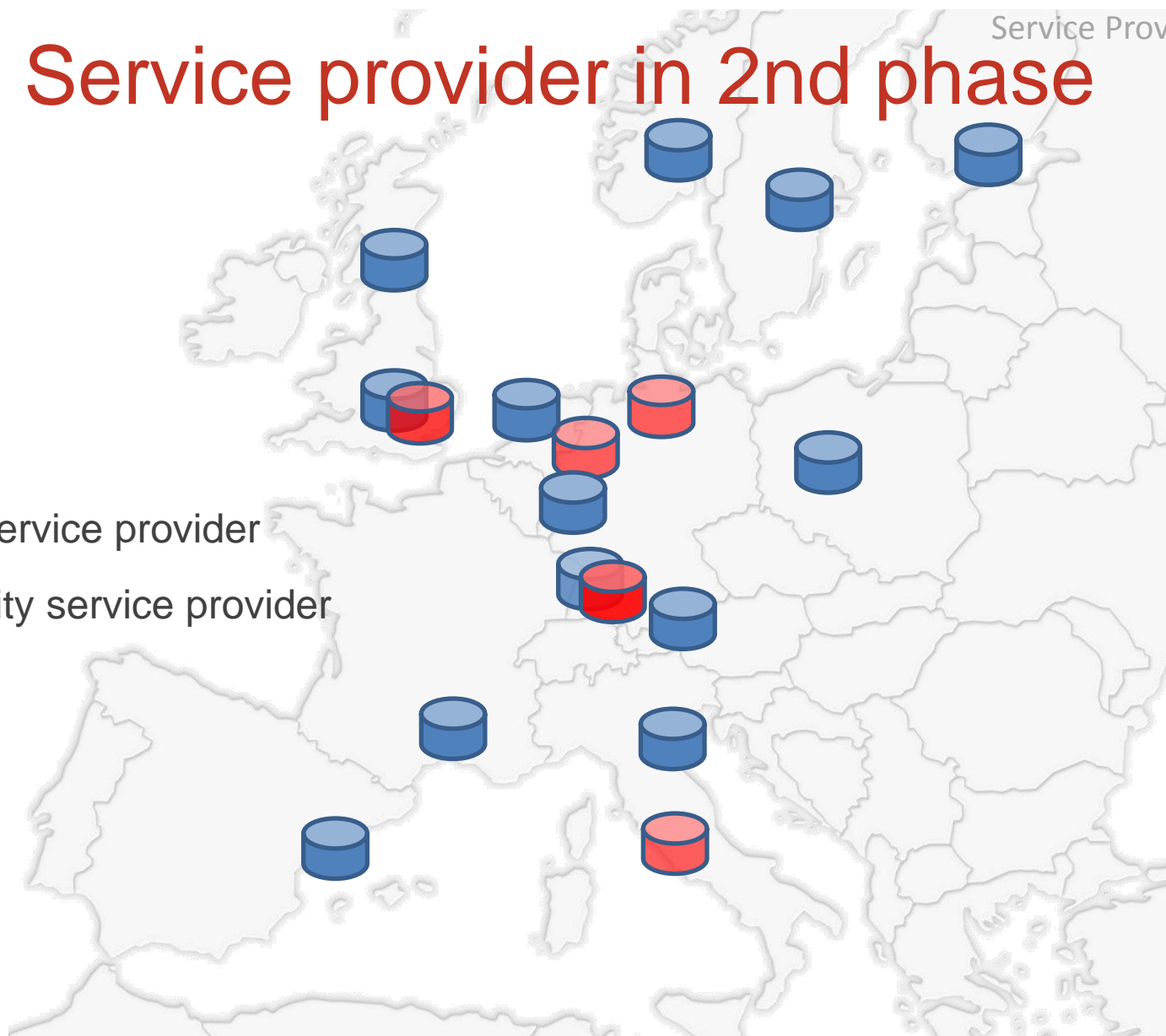
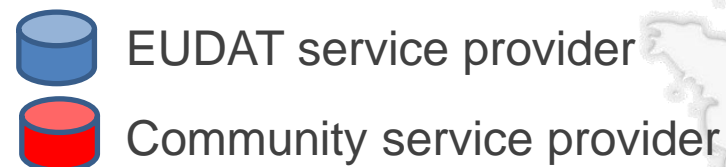
Coordinated Operation



Operational approach (summary)

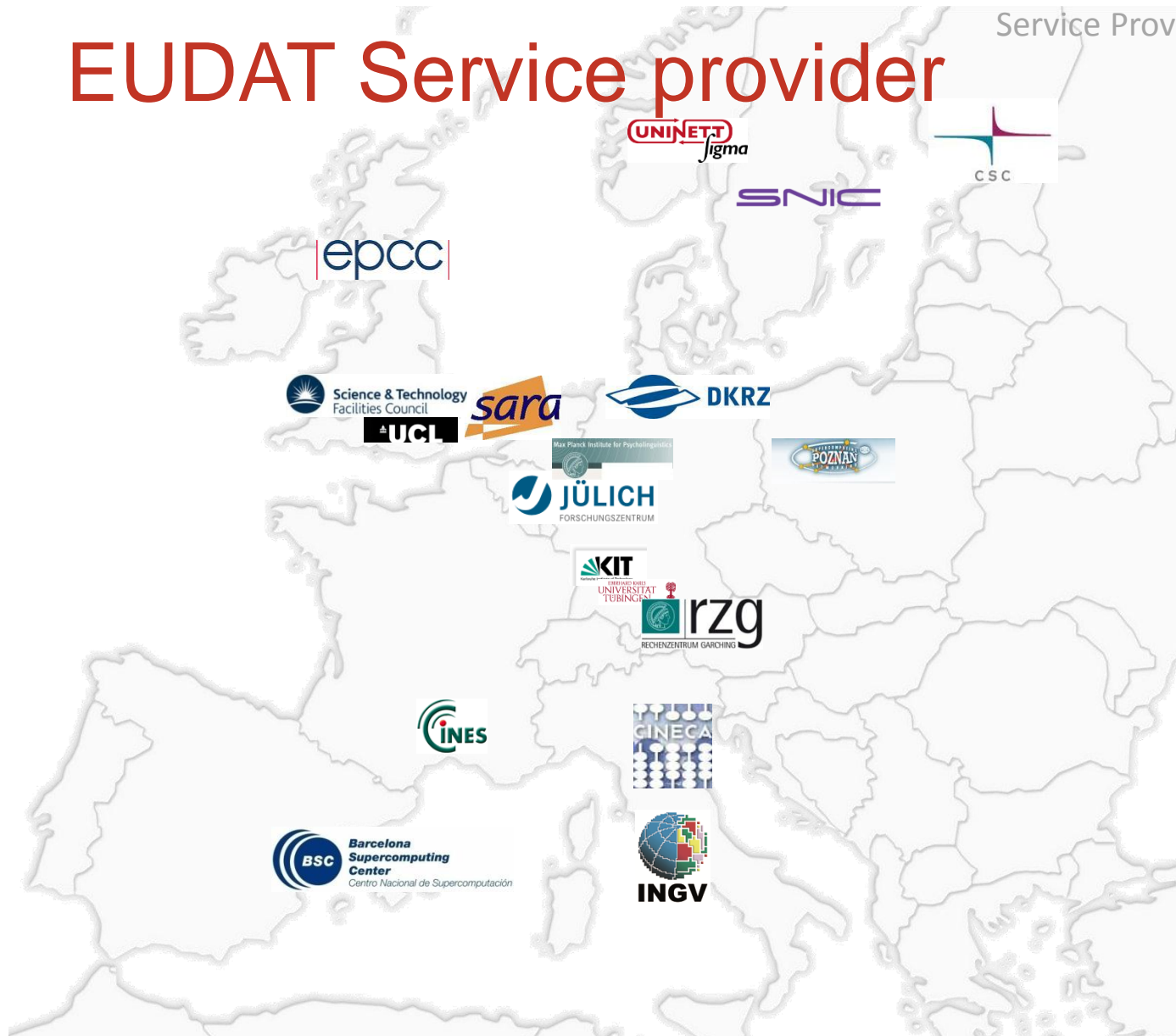
- Coordinated provisioning of network, storage, and compute **Resources**
- Coordinated provisioning of **Services** on top of these resources, including a registry for all the services deployed and operated and service status monitoring
- Coordination of **Operations** via EUDAT teams, integration support for (new) resource/service providers, issue tracking, change management, user support with interfaces to community support teams
- **Coordinated security and quality management**
CSIRT, security and quality management, certification of repositories and centres (Data Seal of Approval)

Service Hosting

Status March 2012

First **centers** are providing resources in a coordinated way. There is a **procedure for requesting resources**.

Resources are provided for

- **services test environment**
- **hosting community services**
- **providing core services**

Community services can be hosted on EUDAT resources.

There is a procedure in place that allows remote service integrators to request specific resources on EUDAT sites, deploy and run community services there.
